

# SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find attached the Meadow Springs Primary School schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2025 endorsed by the School Board. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that your child might incur throughout the school year.

### CONTRIBUTIONS

The total amount of the School Amenities Contribution is **\$60.00** per student.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes a contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments.

## CHARGES FOR EXTRA COST, OPTIONAL COMPONENTS

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, activities etc for 2025 has been included in the schedule below.

*Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity.* The amounts indicated below represent the maximum charged for scheduled activities in 2025. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.

The schedule includes costs for:

- Specific learning activities available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. incursions, excursions.
- Specific learning activities available to selected students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. PEAC, School of Instrumental Music program, etc.
- Other activities available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. graduation celebrations, camps, etc.
- Students who belong to the Choir may be required to supply a Choir uniform- School choir polo shirt, skirt or pants.
